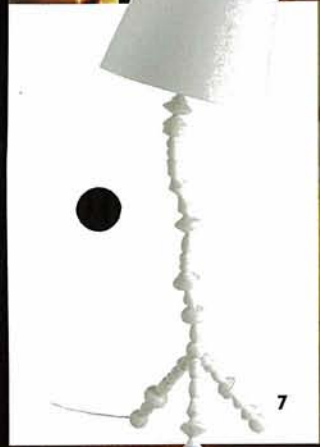
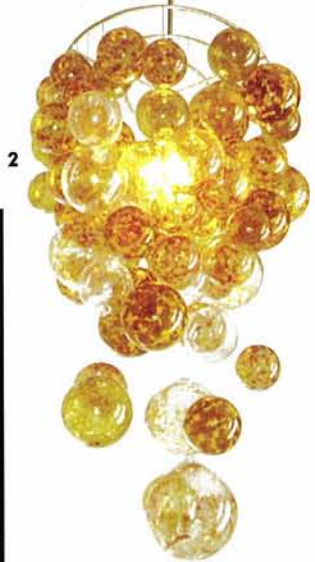

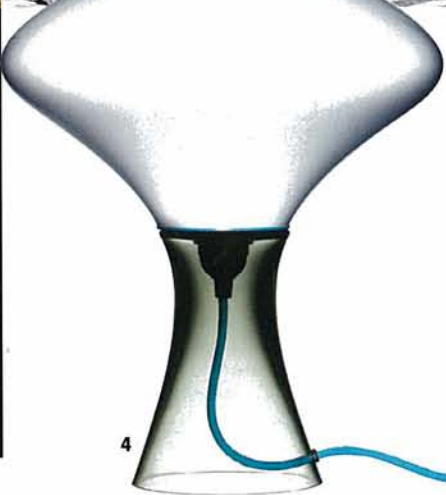




IN SUSPENSE
